It's important to fix any problems before you add insulation or make other improvements. For example, if a wall is damp, it should be dried out before adding insulation.

Applying for energy grant schemes?

If you're thinking about applying for an energy grant to help pay for improvements, make sure to ask:

- **Will the inspection check if there are any repairs needed?**
- **Will the grant help pay for these repairs?**

Some grants won't cover the cost of fixing things (this is sometimes called "enabling works"). It's important to fix any problems first, because if you don't, it could cause bigger issues later that might be more costly and stressful to fix.
